The 2018 WFA Proposed Development Plan

The development Plan for the national federations/associations shall be divided into four parts as following:-

A- Educational Seminars:-

- 1- Organize Anti-Doping education seminar under supervision of the IWF in sideline of organizing the African Youth and Junior Weightlifting YOG Qualification Championships which will be held in Cairo, Egypt on 24th March 2018.
- 2- Organize weightlifting injuries education seminar under supervision of the IWF in sideline of organizing the African Youth and Junior Weightlifting YOG Qualification Championships which will be held in Cairo, Egypt on 25th March 2018.
 - The WFA will be cooperated with two Egyptian professional experts to present these seminars.
- 3- Referees Education Seminar in sideline of organising the African Senior Weightlifting Championships (the date will be determined later)
 - The estimated cost of these seminars is **2400 USD**.

B- Training Camp:-

The WFA will be Conducted one month training camp in Buenos Aires or other city in Argentina from 05th September to 04th October 2018 for the African men and women lifters whom will be qualified to the 2018 Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games with their coaches according to the following conditions:

- a) Arrival date 05/09/2018;
- b) Departure date 04/10/2018;
- c) The WFA will cover the daily accommodation and three meals;
- d) The WFA will cover the cost of training hall;
- e) The concerned national federations/associations should cover the travel and other expenses of their delegations;

- f) The allocated participant number in this training camp as following:
- 1) Four men athletes whom will be qualified after the Continental Qualification Championship;
 - 2) Four women athletes whom will be qualified after the Continental Qualification Championship;
 - 3) If two men and women athletes from the same country will be qualified to YOG, the WFA will cover the daily accommodation and three meals for only one coach.
- The estimated total number of participants in this training camp will be **14 persons**.
 - The estimated cost of this training camp is **14 × 100\$ × 29 nights = 40600 USD**.

C- Equipment Support:-

WFA will donate to ten national federations/associations with 10 costumes, belts and 10 pairs of Footwear with freight charge.

- The estimated cost of these equipment is **35000 USD**.

D- Financial Support:-

- 1- **15000 USD** shall be allocated to Egypt Weightlifting Federation as WFA financial contribution to host the African Youth and Junior Weightlifting YOG Qualification Championships.
- 2- **15000 USD** shall be allocated to Mauritius Weightlifting Federation as WFA financial contribution to host the African Senior Weightlifting Championships.
- 3- **22000 USD** financial support will be provided for two athletes and one coach from ten national federations/associations to give them the opportunity to participate at African Youth and Junior Championships and African Senior Championships.

The total estimated budget of proposed 2018 WFA development plan is **130000 USD**.
