Cairo – Egypt (23<sup>rd</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> March 2018)

## Regulations

### 1- Competition Date and Place:

The competition will be held in Cairo, Egypt from **23<sup>rd</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2018**.

### 2- Competition Rules and Regulations:

The competition will be held and organised in accordance to the IWF 2017-2020 technical and competition rules & regulations.

### 3- Eligibility to Entries:

**A-** According to article (1.1) of IWF 2017-2020 Technical and Competition rules & regulations, the athletes have the eligibility to participate as follows:

- 1) Youth:** 13 – 17 years of age (from 2005 to 2001)
- 2) Junior:** 15 – 20 years of age (from 2003 to 1998)

**B-** With reference to Article (5.6.4) of the IWF Anti-Doping Policy, the Athletes who are not listed in the IWF's registered testing pool and who want to enter an IWF event shall nevertheless register to the ADAMS system and submit proper whereabouts information at least two months before and during the IWF event in question. The athletes who do not comply with this provision are not eligible to compete.



- C-** Only competitors of member federations that has no arrears towards the IWF and WFA are eligible to participate.
- D-** The passport is considered as the sole official document to proof the age and the eligibility of the athlete.
- E-** A maximum of eight (8) men and eight (8) women Junior / Youth competitors could be registered plus two (2) reserves for each gender and age group may also be entered but during the Verification of Final Entries each country can only register (8) men and (8) women Junior / Youth as a final entry without any reserves.
- F-** It is possible to change the bodyweight categories and the entry total latest on the Verification of Final Entries.

#### **4- Competition Events and Categories:**

IWF Categories for Men and Women are follows:

##### **A- Youth Categories:**

###### **Men Youth:**

50kg, 56kg, 62kg, 69kg, 77kg, 85kg, 94kg, +94kg.

###### **Women Youth:**

44kg, 48kg, 53kg, 58kg, 63kg, 69kg, 75kg, +75kg

##### **B- Junior Categories:**

###### **Men Junior:**

56kg, 62kg, 69kg, 77kg, 85kg, 94kg, 105kg, +105kg.

###### **Women Junior:**

48kg, 53kg, 58kg, 63kg, 69kg, 75kg, 90kg, +90kg.



## 5- Entry Forms:

Enclosed herewith please find both Preliminary and Final Entry Forms.

- A- Preliminary** Entry Forms, Accommodation and Transportation Forms must be submitted to both the Organizing Committee (EGY. WF) and the WFA secretariat respectively no later than **31/01/2018**.
- o Maximum athletes allowed on the Preliminary Entry Form are ten (10) women and ten (10) men for each age group.
- B- Final** Entry Forms, Accommodation and Transportation Forms must be submitted to both the Organizing Committee (EGY WF) and the WFA secretariat respectively no later than **28/02/2018**.
- o Maximum athletes allowed on the Final Entry Form are ten (10) women and ten (10) men for each age group; this consists of a full team (eight (8) women and eight (8) men) plus two (2) reserve athletes per gender and age group. Reserve athletes must be noted as such on the Final Entry Form.

## 6- Doping Control:

Doping Control will be conducted during the competition in accordance with the IWF Anti-Doping Policy and will be carried out by the IWF selected DCOs.

## 7- Accommodation:

- A-** The accommodation for all delegations will be at Dar El Modaraat New Hotel located in Salah Salem st - Nasr City, behind Cairo Stadium 20 minutes from Cairo International Air port.
- B-** The hotel will be provided from **23/03/2018** to the end date of the competition with the following normal rates:
- **US \$ 100** full board per person per night for standard double rooms including officials.
  - **US \$ 120** full board per person per night for standard single room for the head of the delegation.



## **8- Accreditation:**

- A-** The federations/associations must send the colored photos for all the delegates (athletes and officials) with the final entry forms.
- B-** Accreditation of the delegations will take place at Dar El Modaraat New Hotel upon arrival.
- C-** Please note that the accreditation will be valid only for the days registered on the accreditation card at the accreditation centre and will be issued only after full payment of Annual subscription and competition entry fees.

## **9- Financial Condition:**

- A-** Only affiliated national federations/associations that have annually paid their subscription fees to IWF and WFA have the right to participate in this competition.
- B-** An Entry Fee of US\$ 150 per person (including US\$ 50 Special Anti-Doping Fee) shall be paid to the WFA by each delegation for all their athletes and officials (Except the officials whom will be appointed to officiate at the competition).
- C-** All payments must be made in cash to the Organization Committee preferably in US Dollars upon arrival at the accreditation center located in Dar El-Modaraat New Hotel.
- D-** The WFA is responsible for the Trophies, Medals and Certificates.
- E-** Each participated national federation has the right to nominate one international referee cat. (1) or (2) to be officiated in the championships and the Organizing Committee will cover the costs of their accommodation and board.
- F-** The Organizing Committee will cover the accommodation and board costs for the WFA Secretariat Members, IWF representatives and IWF selected Doping Control Officers.



### **10- Equipments:**

**A - Barbells:** The IWF approved barbells will be used in Competition & Training.

**B - Results System:** Approved by IWF.

### **11- Competition and Training Venues:**

The competition and training venues will be Dar El Modaraat New Hotel.

### **12- Entry Visa:**

**A-** If an entry visa is required, you could be obtaining the visa from the Egyptian Embassy in your respective country.

### **13- Awards:**

**A-** Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals will be awarded in each bodyweight category for both Junior / Youth men and women in Snatch, Clean & Jerk and Total.

**B-** Trophies will be awarded to the best three national teams in total respectively for both Junior / Youth men's and women's competitions in accordance with IWF team classification.

**C-** Best lifters trophies will be awarded in both Junior / Youth men's and women's events.

**D-** Certificates of participation will be presented to all participants.

- B-** The Organizing Committee (EGY WF) and the WFA are not responsible for any kind of accidents.

Each delegation participating in the competition should bring a minimum of two national flags sized 100cm x 150cm, and a CD of their national anthem. These requirements must be submitted upon arrival at the accreditation center.
